## National Cadets Corp (NCC BOY'S) Social and Extension Activities- 2018-2019

 International Yoga Day: On June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018, 6 to 8am, International Yoga day was celebrated. Dr. Akhilesh Sharma provided his valuable guidance to cadets, ANO and 36 cadets participated in this program. Cadets cleaned Datta Mandir area as a part of Swachha Bharat Abhiyaan, on the same day.





• **Fund collection rally for flood-affected Kerala:** On September 2018, a fund collection rally for the flood-affected people of Kerala was organized in Dhule, where 34 cadets participated. Throughout the day, they collected a total of thirty-four thousand five hundred rupees, which was later handed over to the District Collector's office.
