These programs included a quiz based on the Indian national flag, lectures on "75 years of Independence," a rally for the Flag Awareness Campaign, cultural programs, essay competitions, etc. On 11th August 2022, students participated in an online quiz based on the Indian national flag. On 12th August 2022, a lecture was organized on "75 years of Independence" with Dr. Satish Nikam as the keynote speaker. On the same day, the college principal, Dr. P.H. 
