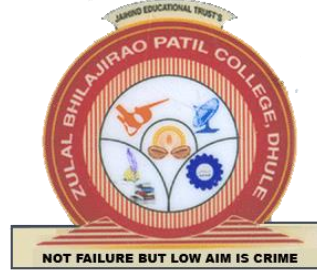

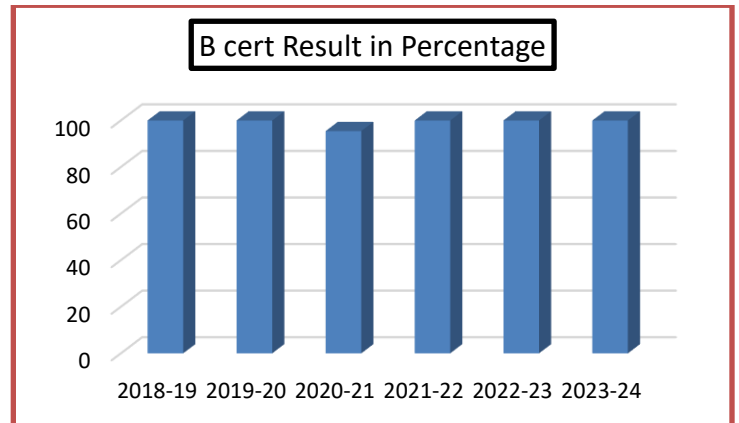

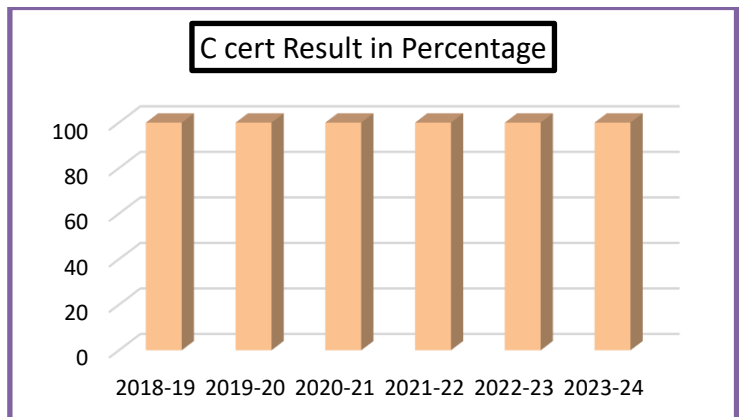

The NCC unit provides all the above items to the cadets & gives them stitching charges, refreshment, washing & polishing allowances & scholarships.

Incentives to NCC Cadets-

The following incentives are given to NCC cadets.

1) Enrolment in Army:-

- a) NCC 'A' Certificate: - 5% bonus marks in the overall marks scored by 'A' certificate holder.
- a) NCC 'B' Certificate: - 10% bonus marks to 'B' certificate holder in the overall marks scored by him.
- b) NCC 'C' Certificate: - Holder of 'C' certificate is exempted from appearing for common Entrance Exam & placed on the top of merit list if they meet the minimum laid down criteria of age, education, qualification, physical & medical standard. They are, however, required to pass physical fitness test.

2) Para Military Forces :-

1. **Border Security Force:** - The following additional marks are given to the NCC certificate holders for recruitment in BSF
 - a) 'A' only - 2
 - b) 'AI' & 'AII' - 4
 - c) 'B' Certificate - 6
 - d) 'C' Certificate - 10
2. **Central Reserve Police:** - For recruitment to gazette post. i.e. for Company Commanders, Quartermasters & Dy. SPs, the minimum prescribed qualification is either a First Class Bachelor's Degree or a Second Class Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks of a recognized University. However, candidates having a Third Class Bachelor's Degree & holding 'B' or 'C' certificate of NCC are also considered eligible for these posts. Other things being equal, candidates having NCC certificates are given preference.
3. **Central Industrial Security Force:** - Direct recruitment of officers to the rank of Assistant Commandant is made through the agency of special selection Board constituted by the Ministry of Home Affairs, preference is given to 'B' & 'C' certificate holders for recruitment in the same manner as given to outstanding sportsmen of candidates who have obtained certificate in athletics proficiency.
4. **Coast Guard:** - Weightage of 15 marks is given to NCC certificate holders for recruitment in the Coast Guard.

3) Government of Maharashtra: -

1. Concession for Employment: -

NCC 'B'/ 'C' Certificate holders are given preference for entry in the state police service.

2. Scholarship & Cash Awards: -

- a) 16 Scholarships to NCC Cadets in each Group.
- b) Director General NCC Scholarship to the best cadet in the Republic Day Camp.
- c) Scholarship to each cadet participating in Republic Day Camp.
- d) Prizes Medals & Trophies etc. for cadets participating in Republic Day Camp.

3. Concessions in the Academic Field: -

- A. University gives maximum of 10 grace marks to NCC cadets appearing at various Degree Examinations.
- B. Bonus marks are given for admission to medical college.
- C. 10 seats are kept reserved for NCC cadets representing state in All India Competition in Engineering College.
- D. 15 seats are kept reserved for NCC cadets representing state in All India Competition in Polytechnics.
- E. Weightage of 4 marks for admission in I.T.I.
- F. Reservation of vacancies is under consideration of the state Govt. as 20 vacancies in I.T.I., 15 vacancies in Home Science, 10 vacancies in medical colleges.
