



Introduction -

This survey is focused on the success story of the village Lamkani, located in Dhule district of Maharashtra, India. The village was known for its grasslands and was rich in fodder, but due to the droughts in the 1970s and 1990s, the village became barren. However, the village restored its grasslands through watershed management and traditional practices of 'charaibandhi' and 'kurhadbandhi,' which have resulted in restoring over 400 hectares of grasslands. The paper highlights the success story of the village and the economic benefits achieved due to the restoration of the grasslands, which led to water sufficiency and reduced distress migration. The paper also highlights the approach taken by the villagers to achieve the restoration and conservation of the grasslands and how it can be replicated in other areas facing similar challenges.


Aim and Objective -

The aim and objective of this was to build a water foundation on a barren land and bring it into use and Lamkani village and help them with the water problems.

Village Study-

According to Census 2011 information the location code or village code of Lamkanivillage is 526465. Lamkani village is located in Dhule tehsil of Dhule district inMaharashtra, India. It is situated 42km away from sub-district headquarter Dhule(tehsildar office) and 42km away from district headquarter Dhule. As per 2009 stats,Lamkanivillage is also agrampanchayat.

Totalgeographicalareaofvillageis2529.42hectares.Lamkanihasatotalpopulationof 6,981 peoples, out of which male population is 3,649 while female population is3,332. Literacy rate of lamkani village is 67.08% out of which 72.18% males and61.49% females are literate. There are about 1,399 houses in lamkani village. Dhuleis nearest town to lamkani for all major economic activities, which is approximately42km away.

Lamkani, a village 40 kilometres from Dhule, was known for its grasslands andfor being fodder- rich in the pre-independence era. The situation changed afterthe drought in the 1970s, and the lush green village became completely barrenafterenduring droughtyears again in the 1990s.

• Lamkanihasrestoreditsgrasslandsthroughwatershedmanagementandareturntoth etraditionalpracticesof charaibandhi'(banongrazing)and'kurhadbandhi'(ban felling trees), managing to restore over 400 hectares of grasslands overitsnowfamousGovardhanhillock,fromwhereallofLamkani'sstreamsoriginate.

Dhananjay Newadkar, a pathologist by profession who hails from Lamkani, initiated the efforts. After suffering an ear-fatal accident that left

himbedridden,Newadkar decided that if he survived the accident, he would attempt to solve hisnativevillage's severe watercrisis.

"Twenty years ago, village did not have 10 litres of milk available in LamkanivillageinDhuledistrict.Today,Lamkanisellsabout3,000litresofmilktoDh

uleevery day," boasts Dhananjay Newadkar, who, in 2000, initiated a watersheddevelopment programme to solve the water scarcity problems of people of hisvillage. But after studying the topography of Lamkani Newadkarrealisedthatwatersheddevelopmentalone will not work to help Lamkanis residents solvetheir water troubles and hye decided to adopt the traditional practice of 'charaibandhi , (ban on felling trees) to conserve the grassland on the hillock.Newadkaralsoapproached all thefolkartistes ofMaharashtra

(tamasha)andkirtankarsthatperformedin Lamkani and ask them toincorporateinformationabout protecting and conservingthe hillock in theirperformances. Theparticipationof the people in watersheddevelopmentaswell asprotecting thehillock increased. Lamkanis success in restoring the grasslandwas achievedthroughrotationalgrazing ,which means that every year a 50 hectare patch of the grassland wouldbeconservedat a time ,not allowing grazingon that patch ,which allowed thepalatablespeciesofgrassestoregenerate.


Droughtresilience and economic benefits-

AfterfourorfiverainfallcyclessinceNewadkarstartedhiswatersheddevelopmentand grassland conservationproject,Lamkaniwent from beingcompletelytanker-dependenttowater-sufficientevenduringdroughtyears.Thewaterat10-

15feetinthewells.Nowatershortageproblemdespitebeinglocatedin a drought – proneregion. Newadkaralso sharedhowthe restoredgrasslandhelpedLamkani endure thechangingrainfallpatterns.Earlier ,the quantum ofrainfallwas not high ,but it wouldrain for much longer.Now,theintensity ofrainfall has increasedso much that itrains fveryheavily,causinga lot of soilerosion and not giving any timefor thewaterto percolateinto the soil. Butgrasses make thesoil spongy, helpingusreducethe soilrunoffand harvestall the rainwaterrightherein Lamkani.

Whithinthefirsttenyears, distress migration reduced considerably, aseveryon had access to water for irrigation Onions, Cotton, wheat, bajri, jowar, and fruits are grownhere, somefermers have startedcultivatingathird watershedmanagement crop.Theinitial in Lamkaniwas done using theMaharashtraEmploymentGuaranteeScheme and later NREGA generatingemploymentfor the villagers. Later, WatershedOrganisationTrust (WOTR)donatedRs.15lakhforthewatersheddevelopmenttothejointForestManage ment Committee of the village, to which the villagers of Lamkani addedRs.65000 to start the CCT diggingproject. Lamkani also participatedin PaaniFoundation's Water Cup in 2018 and 2019.Grasslandhavehistoricallybeenassociated with forestfires and in Lamkanitoo, forest fires are an uncommonoccurrence. The young people of Lamkani have formeda WhatsAppgroupwherenewsof forest firesissharedandhelpisarrangedtocontrol thefires.

"Despitethe challenges, community-protected grasslands have a much higherrateofsuccessasinthesecasesenvironmentalprotectionistiedtothelivelihoodo fthepeople."



Conclusion -

The data and information presented suggest that Lamkani, a village in Dhule district, Maharashtra, has successfully restored its grasslands through watershed management and traditional conservation practices. This has helped the village become drought resilient and water-sufficient even during drought years. The restored grasslands have also helped the village endure changing rainfall patterns and reduced soil erosion. The economic benefits of the project have been significant, with distress migration reducing considerably, and the villagers growing various crops. The success of the project is attributed to the active participation of the community and the adoption of traditional conservation practices. Overall, Lamkani's success provides an excellent example of how a community can come together to conserve the environment and achieve economic benefits.


दुष्काळाची लवचिकता आणि आर्थिक लाभ :-

नेवाडकरांनी पाणलोट विकास आणि गवताळ संवर्धन प्रकल्प सुरू केल्यापासून चार-पाच पावसाच्या चक्रानंतर, लामकानी पूर्णपणे टॅकरवर अवलंबून राहण्यापासून ते पाण्यावर अवलंबून होते-दुष्काळाच्या काळातही पुरेसे होते. विहिरींमध्ये 10-15 फूट पाणी होते. दुष्काळी प्रदेशात असूनही पाणी टंचाईची समस्या नाही. पुनर्संचयित गवताळ प्रदेशामुळे लामकानी पावसाच्या बदलत्या पद्धतींचा सामना करण्यास कशी मदत झाली हे देखील नेवाडकर यांनी सांगितले. पूर्वी, पावसाचे प्रमाण जास्त नव्हते, परंतु जास्त काळ पाऊस पडेल. आता पावसाची तीव्रता इतकी वाढली आहे की, जोरदार पाऊस पडतो. मातीची भरपूर धूप आणि पाणी जमिनीत झिरपण्यास वेळ न देणे. परंतु गवत मातीला स्पॉन्जी बनवते, ज्यामुळे आम्हाला मातीची वाहणे कमी करण्यास मदत होते आणि सर्व पावसाचे पाणी येथेच लामकानीमध्ये साठवले जाते.

पहिल्या दहा वर्षात, त्रासदायक स्थलांतर लक्षणीयरीत्या कमी झाले, कारण प्रत्येकाला सिंचनासाठी पाणी

उपलब्ध होते. कांदे. कापूस. गहू. बाजरी. ज्वारी आणि फळे येथे पिकतात. काही शेतकरी तिसरे पीक घेण्यास सुरुवात करतात. लामकानी येथील सुरुवातीच्या पाणलोट व्यवस्थापन महाराष्ट्र रोजगार हमी योजना आणि नंतर नरेगाचा वापर करून गावकऱ्यांसाठी रोजगार निर्मिती केली. नंतर. वॉटरशेड ऑर्गनायझेशन ट्रस्ट (WOTR) ने गावाच्या संयुक्त वन व्यवस्थापन समितीला पाणलोट विकासासाठी रु. 15 लाख दान केले. ज्यामध्ये लामकानी ग्रामस्थांनी CCT खोदकाम प्रकल्प सुरू करण्यासाठी रु. 65000 जोडले. लामकानी यांनी 2018 आणि 2019 मध्ये पाणी फाउंडेशनच्या वॉटर कपमध्ये देखील भाग घेतला होता. गवताळ प्रदेश ऐतिहासिकदृष्ट्या जंगलातील आगीशी संबंधित आहे आणि लामकानीमध्ये देखील, जंगलात आग ही एक असामान्य घटना आहे. लामकानी येथील तरुणांनी एक व्हॉट्सॲप ग्रुप तयार केला असून त्यामध्ये जंगलातील आगीच्या बातम्या शेअर केल्या जातात आणि आग आटोक्यात आणण्यासाठी मदतीची व्यवस्था केली जाते.

"आव्हाने असूनही, समुदाय-संरक्षित गवताळ प्रदेशांमध्ये यशाचा दर खूप जास्त आहे कारण या प्रकरणांमध्ये पर्यावरण संरक्षण लोकांच्या उपजीविकेशी जोडलेले आहे.



निष्कर्ष :-

सादर केलेल्या डेटा आणि माहितीवरून असे सूचित होते की महाराष्ट्रातील धुळे जिल्हयातील लामकानी या गावाने पाणलोट व्यवस्थापन आणि पारंपारिक संवर्धन पद्धतींद्वारे यशस्वीरित्या गवताळ प्रदेश पुनर्संचयित केला आहे. यामुळे दुष्काळी वर्षातही गाव टंचाई प्रतिरोधक आणि पाणीपुरते होण्यास मदत झाली आहे. पुनर्संचयित केलेल्या गवताळ प्रदेशांमुळे गावाला पावसाच्या बदलत्या पद्धती आणि मातीची धूप कमी होण्यास मदत झाली आहे. या प्रकल्पाचे आर्थिक फायदे लक्षणीय ठरले आहेत, त्रासदायक स्थलांतर लक्षणीयरीत्या कमी झाले आहे आणि गावकरी विविध पिके घेत आहेत. प्रकल्पाच्या यशाचे श्रेय समाजाच्या सक्रिय सहभागाला आणि पारंपारिक संवर्धन पद्धतींचा अवलंब करणे हे आहे. एकंदरीत, लामकानीचे यश हे एक उत्कृष्ट उदाहरण देते की पर्यावरणाचे संवर्धन करण्यासाठी आणि आर्थिक लाभ मिळवण्यासाठी समुदाय कसा एकत्र येऊ शकतो.

The project is allotted during the third semester. The students will get an opportunity to become a part of ongoing research activities in the respective supervisor's laboratory. This should make them familiar with the literature survey and the fundamental understanding of how to devise research methodology. It is expected that the student should learn the synthesis, isolation, purification and characterization techniques whatever applicable for their projects. Students whose projects are dependent on the instruments are expected to know SOP and their working principles. Full flexibility is given to the student in identifying the project depending on the resources and infrastructure available in the host organization. It is recommended to work on multidisciplinary projects but not mandatory. In any case, not more than 2-3 students should involve in the same project. The systematic approach towards the execution of the project should be as follows: Selection of topic relevant to priority areas of chemistry and allied sciences 1. Literature survey and devising research methodology based on the gaps in the literature 2. Good laboratory practices: Safety, MSDS, disposal of chemical waste etc. 3. Execution of the project by designing and performing suitable experiments 4. Interpretation of results and drawing important conclusions 5. To prepare a PowerPoint presentation using modern ICT tools 6. Students should present their research work in Avishkar/Webinars/Conferences 7. Total three bound copies of the dissertation should be prepared (library, guide and student: each one copy). Student should note that plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Beside writing dissertation, students should write a

manuscript/patent if the results obtained are worthy of publication.

Similarly, there exist several other summer internship opportunities in the national institutes, reputed universities and industries. Students should explore these possibilities immediately after the completion of the second semester (M. Sc., Part - 1) meaning that applications should be sent much earlier. The exposure gained during the summer internship should build enough confidence amongst students to identify the right research project and its execution.
